The World's first fully painted feature film. There was more to Van Gogh than just his art, an addiction to absinthe and a missing ear. Loving Vincent uses Van Gogh's letters as reference to frame the artists last troubled days and asks the question was his death, aged 37, suicide or was there a more sinister figure involved.
