March 1918. C-company arrives to take its turn in the French trenches led by war-weary Captain Stanhope (Sam Claflin). A German offensive is imminent, and the officers and their cook (Toby Jones) distract themselves with talk of their past lives. Stanhope, meanwhile, soaks his fear in whisky, unable to deal with the inevitable. Each man is trapped with the days ticking by and the attack drawing ever closer.

Nominated for Best foreign language film at this year's Oscars. Zhenya and Boris are going through a vicious divorce marked by resentment, frustration and recriminations. Already embarking on new lives, they are impatient to start again, even if it means threatening to abandon their 12-year-old son Alyosha. Until, after witnessing one of their fights, Alyosha disappears.



**Brief Encounter (PG) 86mins**

Dir: David Lean | 1945

After a chance meeting on a train platform, a married Doctor and a suburban housewife begin a muted but passionate, and ultimately doomed, love affair. Directed by David Lean and based on the play, *Still Life*, by Noel Coward this is the greatest romance in film history and a perfect Valentine's day treat.

**Trainspotting (18) 94mins**

Dir: Danny Boyle | 1996

Edith Bowman and Soundtracking Podcasts third curated pick is this 90's cult classic. Heroin addict Renton stumbles through bad ideas and sobriety attempts with his unreliable friends Sick Boy, Begbie, Spud and Tommy. He also has an underage girlfriend, Diane, along for the ride. After cleaning up and moving to London, Mark finds he can't escape the life he left behind.
